For those of you who are wondering, "What happened to Butterfield Overland Stage Days at Lions Park?" there have been major changes made.

Due to heavy competition from the Butterfield Rodeo and various other car shows, it was determined that BC&B's event at Lions Park would be better served by changing the date of the event. It was decided to hold the event in September and to change the name to Benson Pony Express Western Days. This allows BC&B to tailor the Western Days to not only encompass the Pony Express but also other aspects of the "West" in future events without having to make major changes in our emphasis.

Planning for next year's event is currently underway to lock in vendors and sponsors. In addition, BC&B has contracted with KIMM FM radio to give us some prime time advertising and a two hour live broadcast during the event. By working with KIMM, we will receive advertising promoting the event and, hopefully bring more people from Tucson and other cities to our event.
